Schedule: Friday access to the facility available at 1 p.m. until one hour after the conclusion of the trial. The obedience trial starts at 2.30 p.m.

Pre-entries will be accepted from 2-2.15 p.m.

Saturday and Sunday: facility access at 7:30 a.m. until one hour after the conclusion of the afternoon trials.

Trial #1 (a.m.): starts at 9:05 a.m. Trial #2 (p.m.) will begin approximately 30-40 minutes after the end of Trial #1; no earlier than 11:30 a.m.

'Day of Show' entries (if available) will be taken from 8.45 a.m. until 8.55 a.m. and for approximately 10 minutes before Trial #2 starts.

Additional Information:

1. Entry must be on newer entry forms (version Oct. 2020) which can be found on the ASCA website (www.asca.org), go to 'Quick Links', 'Rules & Forms', 'Rally Forms' (<https://asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/rallyentryform.pdf>). Incorrect or missing information (including signature) will invalidate entries. Please use one entry form per dog.
2. No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Rally program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA. Bitches in season are not allowed to compete.
3. **No entry fees will be refunded after the close of pre-entries with the exception of a refund for a bitch in season or an injured dog.**
4. **Make checks payable to COAST and mail to Nancy Fitzhugh. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There is a \$35 service charge for returned checks.**
5. These trials will be held under the current rules and regulations of ASCA.
6. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS and keep your dog on a leash when not competing. Please do not let your dogs urinate on any buildings, park structures, or trash cans.
7. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of ASCA rules and regulations. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
8. ASCA trials are open to all breeds, including mixed breeds, with an ASCA Registration or ASCA QTracking number. Form is available at: <https://asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2022/06/qtsvcapp.pdf>. Although we will have forms available at the trial, we encourage you to apply for a QTracking number beforehand. Applications can be found on the ASCA website. Please bring a separate check payable to ASCA is required for forms submitted at the trial. ***NEW*** FEO option for obedience – dogs are not required to have an ASCA QT or ASCA registration number.
9. COAST and SLOGDOG, their Board of Directors, ASCA, its Board of Directors and the host, Jane Brennan, assume NO RESPONSIBILITY for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs, personal property, and/or children.
10. Show Grounds: The show grounds are the boundaries of the grounds on which ASCA events are being held. They include, but are not limited to, all areas outside the ring/trial arena (including the buffer zone) set aside for grooming, holding of dogs, and parking of vehicles of the exhibitor.

TRIAL SITE DIRECTIONS:

From the North: Take Highway 101 south the CA-41/Morro Road exit. Turn left towards CA-41 East and continue on CA-41 for approximately 5 miles.

From the South: Take Highway 101 north to the CA-41/Morro Road exit. Turn left onto El Camino Real, then take the first right onto CA-41 East and continue on CA-41 for approximately 5 miles.

After the switchback grade, the road will begin to straighten. Turn left onto Poco Road (just before the curve), then take an immediate right into the gated entrance with a large overhang and teal stars on the gate (addressed 2991 & 2989 Poco). Follow the driveway on the right towards the dark colored house. The ring is located just right of the house.
