ENTRIES: Entries will be accepted by mail or on-line. Entries are limited to 37 dogs per trial. Entries open Dec. 1, 2026 and close at 8:45 am on Jan. 30, 2027 for Trial 1 and 11:15 am for Trial 2, or when trials are full. Early bird pricing for entries received before Jan. 15 is \$25 per element, \$20 for Junior Handlers. After Jan. 15, entry fee is \$30 per element, \$25 for Junior Handlers. All dogs must have a valid UKC registration number. They may be [permanently registered](#), have a [Performance Listing number](#), or a valid [Temporary Listing Number](#). No entries will be accepted without payment.

AWARDS: A Qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all qualifiers. A Title ribbon will be awarded to dogs who have passed 2 legs in any element.

REFUND POLICY: Refund requests received prior to the closing dates will be honored. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused from the trial site for any reason. No fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public, or any other cause beyond the control of the show committee. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The show club or their agents assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury, sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or any of their dogs or property. Dogs **MUST** have a UKC registration or listing number to be entered. Refund for injured dog-WITH Veterinary documentation up to 24 hours before trial date. No refund if exhibitor is sick or injured. No refund for personal issues. Shows will be held, unless shut down by the state for unknown reasons. Entry fees will be refunded for bitches in season, upon receipt by the Trial Secretary, of a request and a letter from your veterinarian. The Trial Secretary must receive the request prior to the trial date. Any requests made after the trial date will not be honored. Wait list will be established. Entry Fees refunded if not able to get into the trial. Dogs pulled after closing date will be refunded if entry can be filled from the waitlist.

SUBSTITUTION POLICY: No substitutions are allowed.

WAIT LIST: A wait list will be maintained to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial closing date. Canceled entries will be filled from the wait list up until 48 hours before the start of the trial. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date. If an entry is withdrawn after the closing date a full refund will only be issued if the entry is replaced by a wait listed entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

MOVEUPS: No move ups.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

From the north: Take US 101 South to exit 220A. Turn left onto Traffic Way. Turn right onto Lewis Ave. Just past E Mall turn right into the parking lot of the museum.

From the south: Take US-101 North to exit 219 for CA-41. Turn left onto El Camino Real. Turn right onto E Mall. Across from the City Hall building turn right into the parking lot of the museum.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. All events are held under the Rules and Regulations of the United Kennel Club, Inc. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.
2. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs may be consumed while competing in UKC-licensed events.
3. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any exhibitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
4. UKC, SLODOG, their agents, and their employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators or by exhibitors, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians. UKC and SLODOG are not responsible for loss, accidents or theft.
5. Exhibitors and dog owners are expected and required to clean up after their own dogs. Any person witnessing a violation of this rule must report it to the Event Committee. The Event Committee may ask any person violating this rule to leave the event grounds. No refund will be made if an exhibitor is asked to leave the grounds.
6. UKC encourages exhibitors to present their dogs in a natural appearance. Dogs should be clean, with nails cut to a length suitable for the dog to perform at the trial. UKC enforces rules against artificially altering pigment and coat color, coat texture, and surgical alterations as outlined in the UKC Rules and Regulations.
7. Crating will be in your car. Dogs may not be left unattended when crated in soft mesh crates. No dog may be left in a crate which is not securely closed.

8. Except when being judged or crated, dogs must be kept on leash.
9. Parking will be open to exhibitors at 7:30 am. Please do not arrive before this time.
10. There will be absolutely NO SMOKING in all areas.
